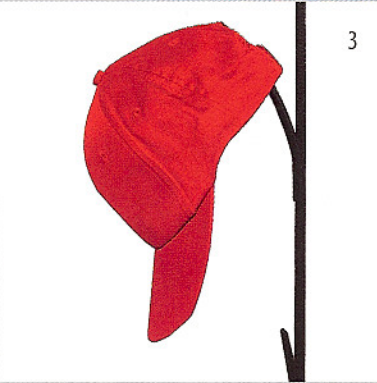
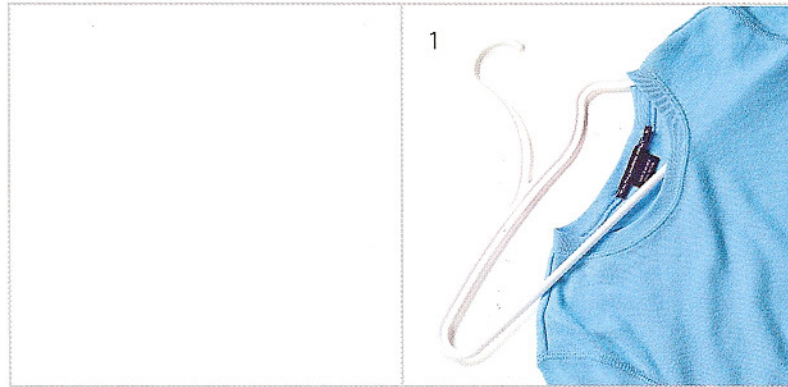




# 20 CLEVER CLOSET SOLUTIONS *for under \$20*

[1] **Shirt Saver Hangers** eliminate the problem of misshapen shirts and sweaters. Their innovative design allows you to slip your shirts easily on and off the hangers without stretching their collars. [2] **Twirl-A-Tie** may not be a fancy motorized organizer, but if you're up to the challenge of turning your own tie rack, the Twirl-A-Tie will hold up to 20 ties for just a fraction of the price — no batteries required. [3] **Cap Racks** will keep eight hats neatly contained behind your door. At such a low price, it might be worth picking up a few of them if you have a big collection. [4] **10-Hole Scarf Hangers** provide an alternative to draping scarves over standard hangers (and finding them at the bottom of the closet after a couple of days). [5] **Round-A-Belt** features a creative wavy design that allows it to separate the rings that hold your belts. The rings are clamped shut, so you won't have to worry about belts sliding off. You could even use the rings to organize the belts by color or style. [6] **Garment Organizer Tags** are the perfect solution for keeping your hanging clothes sorted. They just slip over your closet rod, so you can organize your closet into sections. [7] **Cedar Hang-Ups** also slip over your closet rod and provide an economical way to get the scent of a cedar-lined closet.
